

History

The original Connecticut Horse Advisory (1969 - 1970) was formed to defeat proposed legislation that would have prohibited the use of bits, spurs and other devices. Over 400 horse people testified at the legislative hearing.

The Advisory ultimately evolved into the Connecticut Horse Council (CHC) Incorporated in June 1971.

Since then the CHC, Inc., a nonprofit volunteer organization, has served the Nutmeg State by keeping horse owners updated on legislative, zoning, trail, safety and educational issues, and continues to pursue a state Equestrian Center.
